HAMILTON SUICIDE PREVENTION STRATEGY DECLARATION OF SUPPORT

PRINCIPLES: The Hamilton Suicide Prevention Strategy has its foundations in the following:

- 1. Suicide prevention is everyone's business.
- 2. We can influence societal attitudes and conditions.
- 3. Services for suicide prevention, intervention and postvention should:
 - a. Be respectful, non judgemental, caring and free of stigma and discrimination.
 - b. Take into account cultural, linguistic and gender diversity, sexual orientation and the needs of those with lived experience.
 - c. Be coordinated and collaborative.
 - d. Include, where possible, the appropriate involvement of family and community members in aftercare.
 - e. Be effective and informed by evidence.
 - f. Be adequately funded.

THE PURPOSE of the Strategy is to guide the development of an integrated, coordinated, comprehensive suicide prevention approach in the Hamilton community.

THE AIM of the Strategy is to help prevent deaths due to suicide and reduce the suffering related to suicidal ideation, attempts and those bereaved by suicide.
